KIT CONTENTS

Bumper	6 x M10 Lock nuts
Steering guard plate	4 x M6 Lock nuts
4 x M10x110mm	2 x 13mm Spacers
2 x M10x130mm	
4 x M6x20mm	

TOOLS REQUIRED

13mm Socket	13mm Spanner
17mm Socket	17mm Spanner
19mm Socket	19mm Spanner

INSTRUCTIONS

- Remove the four bolts securing the original bumper and discard (fig 1).
- Remove the two bolts securing the towing eyes and discard.
- For BA 7567, BA 7568 and BA 7571 (Non air con versions) you will need to cut the radiator surround panel.
- Offer the bumper on to the end of the chassis and mark panel (fig 2).
- Cut out the marked section of the panel.
- Install the bumper (all versions) on the chassis rail and locate the four M10 x 110mm bolts through the bumper and chassis. Please note this will require 2 people due to the weight of the bumper.
- Install the two M10 x 130mm bolts through the side of the bumper slot and chassis.
- If you have a steering guard with brackets mounted to the inside of the chassis discard the two 13mm spacers.
- If you do not have a steering guard then insert the spacers in the bolts between the chassis and inside edge of bumper bracket.
- Attach the M10 lock nuts to all six bolts and tighten. Please note the inside bracket will pull up against either the spacers or steering guard brackets when tightened correctly.
- Finally install the steering guard plate to the front of the number using M6 bolts and nuts (fig 3).

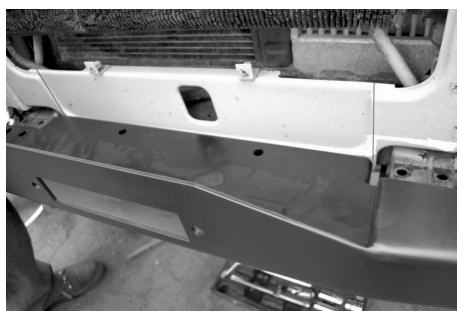
